Teven Valley Tea Tree Mulch is used to cover soils in gardens & pots to protect, enrich & enhance the beauty of your garden.

Teven Valley Tea Tree Mulch

Teven Valley Tea Tree Mulch is the leaves and stems of the tea trees (*Melaleuca Alternafolia*) grown on Teven Valley Tea Tree Plantation.

During harvesting the stems and leaves are finely chopped. By a process of steam distillation the essential oil is extracted from the leaves.

The remaining leaf and stem material (the tea tree mulch) is then left to age for a time before being bagged.

What is mulch?

Mulch is any material placed over the soil in order to:

- Conserve moisture,*
- Keep plant roots cooler,*
- Minimise water erosion,*
- Discourage weeds,*
- Reduce moisture loss on hot days.*

What is Tea Tree Mulch?

Tea Tree Mulch is an organic mulch. An organic mulch is made from plant material. It breaks down to make humus to give a better environment and soil structure for many plants and also helps to increase micro organism activity.

Additional Advantages of Tea Tree Mulch

Stable on the ground. It isn't blown away by wind and can cope with steeper slopes.
Not conducive to snails or cockroaches.
Adds nutrients to the soil.

How Long Will Tea Tree Mulch Last?

Approximately 12 months in this climate.

PH Levels

Testing of the tea tree mulch indicated PH levels of 6 to 6.6. A soil PH of 5.5 to 7 is satisfactory for most plants.

How to Use Tea Tree Mulch

Once garden has been prepared, place a 5-10 cm layer of tea tree mulch on top of the soil. Always leave a space around the stems of plants and trees.

Note

Plants subject to root rots or needing dryish, sharply drained light soils are better mulched with gravel or rocks.
